looked miserable, "I can't dance. I can't move at all" they <sup>said.</sup>



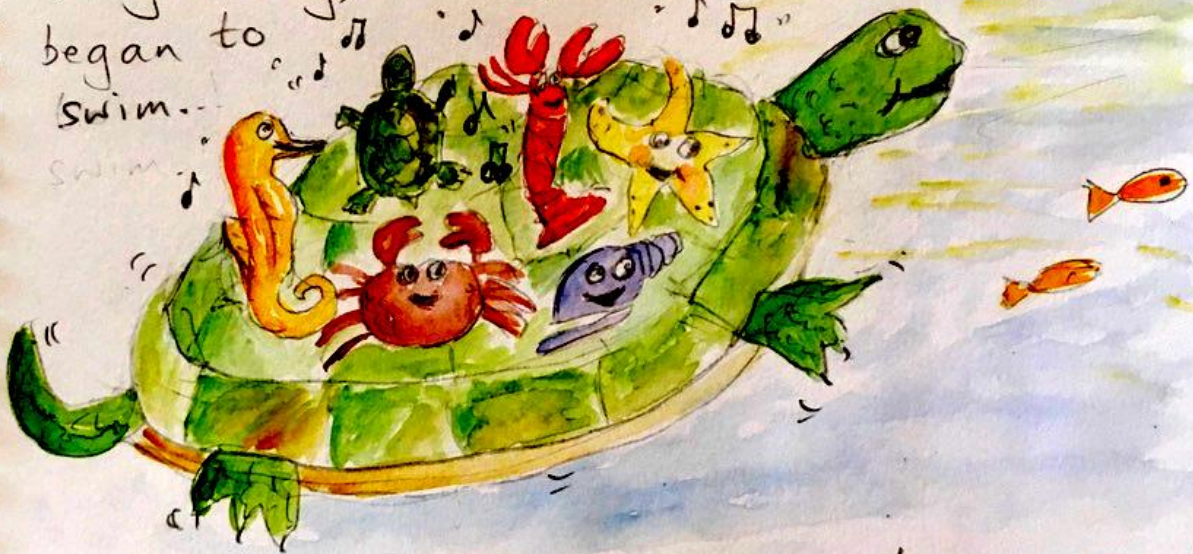
Sunday Turtle swam past them
